Participants will receive a letter from the Parade Committee with instructions and directions to access the parade lineup formation. An early reminder that Bradshaw Road at Route 7 is closed for those arriving from that direction. Winners will be notified within the week following the parade and invited to the July 17th meeting of the GKCA for awards and trophy presentations in the above categories.
